	Confirm final guest count with the venue and caterer.	
	Create seating charts and place cards.	
	Prepare a wedding day kit – think band-aids, safety pins, mints, etc.	
<u>1 Week Before the Wedding</u>		
	Confirm vendor arrival times and share a final timeline.	
	Drop off décor items or favors at the venue if allowed.
